Submissions need to be high-quality digital files (minimum 300dpi).
We accept the following formats: JPEG/PNG/TIFF/PDF.

How to Submit

We prefer that contributions are submitted via our [Google form](#). If this is a barrier for you, we can also accept submission via email or arrange another appropriate method.

If submitting via email:

- Emails need to be sent to BYS@brimbank.vic.gov.au from your best contact email address as we will need to remain in contact with you during the editing process.
Include "The Bold Source - Front Cover Design" in the subject line of your email.
 - Be sure to include your name, age, and your relationship to the city of Brimbank in the body text of your email.
 - Provide your 300dpi JPEG/PNG/TIFF/PDF file as an attachment.
